Class participants will complete **Gallup CliftonStrengths Assessment**, and the **NERIS Analytics Limited 16 Personalities Test.** The Chamber provides access codes/information ahead of the course. These tools benefit the individual, the team as a whole, and can be applied/used in any workplace.

Participants read the book Strengths Based Leadership: Great Leaders, Teams, And Why People Follow By Tom Rath Barry Conchie. Books are provided to participants. During the class series, participants will watch a recorded public meeting that is relevant to the class material.

The 2025 class will be supporters for a small, **new public artwork**, **as part of the Postage Stamp Series**. Chamber staff secure a location and select the artist. Class participants review and select the final design. When the artwork is complete, a Ribbon Cutting event will be held and class participants are invited.
